**Continued Higher Education Closures due to Isaac**

BATON ROUGE, La.- The following community and technical colleges remain CLOSED due to recovery efforts as a result of Hurricane Isaac:

- **Delgado Community College** in New Orleans continues to have difficulty in getting electricity turned on at its main campus. This has led to other electrical, mechanical and telephone infrastructure issues.
- **South Central Louisiana Technical College-River Parishes Campus** in Reserve remains inaccessible due to high water. While the buildings on campus received no damage due to flooding, the parking lots and streets surrounding the campus do have standing water that has yet to recede. SCLTC-River Parishes plans to re-open to full operations on Friday, September 7, 2012.
