RE: PARCC Campus Leadership Team Meeting – March 14, 2014

The fourth statewide meeting for the PARCC Campus Leadership Teams will take place on Friday, March 14, 2014 from 10:00 AM – 2:30 PM at the West Baton Rouge Conference Center, 2750 North Westport Drive, Port Allen, Louisiana. Costs for travel will be *reimbursed* by the Louisiana Board of Regents through the Core to College grant based upon State travel regulations. A copy of the meeting agenda has been enclosed.

The primary purpose of the meeting will be for PARCC Campus Leadership Team members to obtain updates pertaining to the Common Core State Standards, PARCC assessments, and Smarter Balance assessments to disseminate to campus leaders and faculty. In addition, team members will be provided information about available resources and will meet to discuss new resources that will be needed as the Common Core State Standards and PARCC assessments are implemented in 2014-15 and the future. Small group discussions will first occur as campus teams discuss individual campus needs. Small group discussions will next occur as faculty meet in two separate rooms to have cross state discussions about needed resources for mathematics and needed resources for English/literacy as the new standards and assessments are implemented across Louisiana. Cross state teams will then meet as a large group and share key issues that were discussed pertaining to mathematics and English/literacy. This information will be used by the State to identify ways to address the needs during 2014-15 and the future when Core to College funds are no longer available in Louisiana.

Kunjan Narechania with the Louisiana Department of Education will provide current information pertaining to the Louisiana Department of Education's plans to implement the Common Core State Standards and PARCC assessments. I will provide information pertaining to the adaptation of the Board of Regents current placement policy and future plans. Dr. Allison Jones with PARCC Inc. will provide updates about PARCC from a national perspective and will discuss the assessment that is being created by another consortium (Smarter Balance).

New information will be discussed at the statewide meeting, and it will be important for this information to be shared with campus leaders and campus faculty. It is anticipated that bills will be filed by legislators regarding the Common Core State Standards, and all campus leaders need to possess accurate information about what is happening in Louisiana and what is happening nationally.

We would appreciate it if you would complete the attached form to identify from two to four team members that will be participating in the statewide meeting. At least one team member needs to be present to provide input about the need for mathematics resources and at least one team member needs to be present to provide input about the need for English/literacy resources. Please verify that the team members will attend the meeting on March 14, 2014 before placing their names on the list.
