The Louisiana Board of Regents announces the search for the 8th Commissioner for Higher Education

Baton Rouge, LA- The Louisiana Board of Regents has officially launched its national search for the next Commissioner of Higher Education. This individual will lead the Regents' efforts to coordinate the state's four systems of higher education, ultimately to strengthen the educational landscape of our state. The new Commissioner will balance and promote the Board of Regents' oversight of interconnected missions in P-20 education, research, and public service.

An 8-member search committee has been appointed, and is charged with finding the best qualified individual to lead Louisiana higher education.
