In recognition of the maturity and stability of the LONI Network, Commissioner of Higher Education, Joseph C. Rallo approved the LONI Management Council's recommendation to change the name of LONI from the Louisiana Optical Network Initiative to the Louisiana Optical Network Infrastructure. In accompanying this change, LONI is also re-branding its image in the form of a new logo.

"Through the hard work of everyone involved, LONI has grown from an initiative to a relied-upon, economical infrastructure fostering knowledge sharing and opportunity for Louisiana institutions," said Bettina Owens, chairperson of the LONI Management Council. "The name change is long overdue."
