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SB 117

AFFORDABLE TEXTBOOKS

Increase college affordability and student success through the utilization of open education resources. Provide cost transparency to students when registering for classes by marking which courses exclusively use low- or no-cost course materials.

SB 194

DUAL ENROLLMENT OPPORTUNITY

Maximize participation and provide equitable access to at least two dual enrollment (DE) courses per school year, at no cost to eligible and interested high school juniors and seniors.

HB 294

SEXUAL ASSAULT CLIMATE SURVEYS

Amend current law to allow for increased response rates and broader utility of the anonymous sexual assault climate surveys administered by postsecondary campuses.

HB 562

PROPRIETARY SCHOOLS LAW UPDATE

In collaboration with proprietary school owners and stakeholders, rewrite the existing proprietary schools statute to eliminate ambiguity and redundancy, provide clarity and promote consumer protection.

HB 576

LUMCON & LOUIS CARRYOVER AUTHORITY

Ensure cash flow stability for the LA Universities Marine Consortium (LUMCON) and the LA Library Network (LOUIS) by codifying the authority to carry over interagency transfers and self-generated revenue.
