On a motion from Regent David, seconded by Regent Weill, the Facilities and Property Committee unanimously recommended that the Board of Regents approve the Small Capital Projects and 3<sup>rd</sup> Party Project Report as presented in the Consent Agenda.

## IV. Act 959 Project: Nunez Community College Aerospace Manufacturing Building Renovation

The Louisiana Community and Technical College System Board of Supervisors, on behalf of Nunez Community College (Nunez), recently entered into a Cooperative Endeavor Agreement with St. Bernard Parish permitting Nunez the use of a 13,500 SF facility to operate an aerospace manufacturing program. The program has been developed with industry partners (particularly Boeing) to prepare students for entry-level aerospace manufacturing technology positions. The facility previously housed an indoor handball and racket ball arena with additional reception and office space. In order to operate the aerospace program within this facility, significant enhancements and improvements are required. The project scope involves renovating the facility to provide for classrooms, shops, conference rooms, and student leisure areas. The facility also has several large bays that are ideally suited for the college's intended use. The project cost is not to exceed \$3M and will be funded through a combination of grant funding, self-generated revenues, and possibly parish funding.

On a motion from Regent Temple, seconded by Regent Ewing, the Facilities and Property Committee unanimously recommended that the Board of Regents approve the Act 959 project submitted by the Louisiana Community and Technical College Board of Supervisors, on behalf of Nunez Community College, to renovate a facility for the purpose of creating an aerospace technology manufact.

#### V. Other Business

Mr. Herring updated the Board on the status of Louisiana Tech University's tornado recovery

efforts, the effects of Hurricane Barry on the Louisiana Universities Marine Consortium, the status of

fiscal year 2019-20 deferred maintenance and demolition funding appropriated to higher education,

the upcoming schedule of capital outlay site visits as well as the facility summit on September 12,

2019.
